## 3 Event Features

### A. New “42424” semester structure

The Academy’s traditional semester structure was “16+2” with student projects or performances arranged in the last two weeks of the semester. From 2022/23 academic year onward, it will become “42424” to offer two more weeks for activities. This means that for every four weeks of study students will have a chance to apply what they learn, which increases the creative interaction among students from different disciplines and encourage the development of their creative potentials.
