

Typhoons and Rainstorms Arrangement

If Typhoon Signal No. 8 or above is hoisted by the Hong Kong Observatory

For classes that have already started:
Classes will be suspended automatically.

For classes that have not yet started:
Classes for the day will be cancelled.

If Typhoon Signal Pre-No. 8 or above is announced by the Hong Kong Observatory

For classes that have already started:
Classes will be continued until Typhoon Signal No. 8 or above is hoisted

For classes that have not yet started:
Classes for the day will be cancelled.

If Black Rainstorm Warning is in force by the Hong Kong Observatory

For classes that have already started:
Classes will be continued

For classes that have not yet started:
Classes for the day will be cancelled.

If Typhoon Signal No. 8 or above is lowered, or the Black Rainstorm Warning is withdrawn:

At or before 7am

All classes to be held from 9am and thereafter will take place as usual

At or before 10am

All classes to be held from 1pm and thereafter will take place as usual

At or before 2pm

All classes to be held from 5pm and thereafter will take place as usual

Classes will continue as usual if Typhoon Signal No. 1 or 3 or Amber or Red Rainstorm Warning are hoisted. (For children and teenagers courses, parents are reminded that they are solely responsible for the safety of their children under such conditions).

No make-up class or refund will be arranged for classes cancelled due to bad weather.
