




Location

• Campus Map





Transportation in Hong Kong

You can purchase an Octopus card at \$150 (deposit \$50 + usable value of \$100). The card is usable on all trains, ferries and buses. You can even use it for payment at supermarkets, convenience stores and certain restaurants. The Octopus card can be purchased and refunded at any Mass Transit Railway (MTR) stations.

Payment Methods

- Currency: The Hong Kong dollar (HK\$) is the unit of currency used in Hong Kong. One US Dollar is about HK\$7.80. Most foreign currencies and traveller's cheques can be changed at banks, hotels and moneychangers.
- Most international credit cards, such as American Express, VISA, and MasterCard, are accepted at hotels, shops, and restaurants.
- Some stores also accept mobile payments like Apple Pay, Google Pay, Alipay, and WeChat Pay.
- There are still some shops and restaurants in Hong Kong that only accept cash or Octopus cards (Transport card in Hong Kong), you can purchase or rent an Octopus card, or download the tourist version of the Octopus app to your mobile phone.

Other information for Packing

- Temperature (June): 26-30 °C (average 28°C)
- Rain: one of the wettest months of the year, on average it rains 19 days out of the month
- What to pack: Wear light and breathable clothing, but also prepare a jacket as air-conditioning may be strong in indoor areas such as shopping malls and on public transport.
 Remember to bring an umbrella or light rain gear, as there may be monsoons in the summer. Mosquito repellent and sunglasses are also recommended for extended outdoor activities.

- Adaptors: UK-style plug, three-pronged
- Voltage: 220 volts AC, 50Hz
- Stay Connected: SIM card (3G, 4G, 5G), Wi-Fi hotspots (Free Wi-Fi is available within HKAPA area)

- Medications: Bring any personal items and medications you will need during your time abroad. Although pharmacies and grocery stores are easily found in many major cities, be sure to bring personal items and necessary medications with you, especially if you require a specific brand or prescription that can't easily be found or filled abroad.
