In today's ever-changing world, challenges and opportunities come in tandem, and education, being at the frontline of societal development, has to evolve accordingly. As The Hong Kong Academy for Performing Arts celebrates its 35th anniversary, its pursuit of innovation never ceases.

This year, besides welcoming a new Head of Contemporary Dance, Dam Van Huvnh, the Academy community greets a new Head of Project Management (Chinese Opera), Buck Ng.

Born in Vietnam, raised in the US and long based in the UK, renowned choreographer and dancer Dam Van Huynh has chosen to settle in Hong Kong after travelling across the globe and receiving multiple awards. After running a dance studio in the UK for some years. Huynh has decided to contribute to the industry not by presenting more performances, but through sharing his experience with younger dancers.

Dancing is so pivotal to him that the course of his life would have been completely different without it. A refugee who migrated to the US after the Vietnam War, he believes dancing has helped him to self-actualise and find ways to succeed.

"I took part in community projects that were designed to keep young people off the streets, and which gave me the

was how empowerment first came to him as a child growing up in the US. while teaching him that education is a powerful tool for empowering others.

Huynh becomes the new Head of Contemporary Dance at The Hong Kong Academy for Performing Arts seven years after his last visit as an artist-inresidence. He describes the feeling as an "oddity" - he has never lived in Asia since leaving Vietnam as a child.

"It would be selfish to believe that I could just keep taking and never give back, so education has always been at the forefront of my mind." he adds.

From a place with only one or two Asian artists to one full of committed young Asian souls, for Huynh, who was raised and educated in the US, being able to teach at the Academy is like a "homecoming".

"It was quite inspiring," he says. "My cultural heritage was really prevalent at that time, so Hong Kong has become a symbol of my empowerment."

The Academy's supportive environment, allied to Huvnh's ambition, is a breeding ground for new ideas. When one's cris de cœur become reality, the impact can be unprecedented, like a contemporary dancer who breaks through essentialism and embraces the beauty of each dancing style.

Due to his diverse cultural background, he has built a link between his cultural exchanges and his aesthetic expression. He also shares the same sort of thoughts Hong Kong dance students typically have, as he seeks to bring a sense of empowerment to the department.

Dance students at the Academy provide him with a lot to think about. On the one hand, students are "eager and hungry for new information and new ideas", which he thinks is key to their success. On the other hand, he believes the students' mind-set has become one of their challenges.

"It took a little bit of a rebellious mind for me to say: 'Look, mum! I would really like to do this.' I think perhaps it's something we have to do together to change the culture," he says.

"I find that young artists here are guite creative in their thinking and

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articulation, but perhaps the fear of occupying space is also there," he adds. So he encourages Academy students to "embody space, take up space and occupy that."

"I always tell people that the art form itself is a humanist art form," he says. "If we can harness our primal instinct that makes us human, this will connect not only ourselves but the people we work with. Being an Asian artist in the 21st century is a special thing that needs to be embraced."

While contemporary dance may be considered the epitome of a modern art form, Chinese opera is a living fossil imbued with centuries of history and culture. Thus, the Academy's School of Chinese Opera has established different courses, including a Bachelor of Fine Arts in Chinese Opera and other diploma courses, to introduce new blood to the Chinese opera industry and promote the art form internationally.

The new Head of Project Management (Chinese Opera), Buck Ng, has been dedicated to education for many years. Before assuming his new role, he worked at the Academy's Innovation Hub (iHub), offering advice on teachers' professional development and e-learning. He has now shifted his focus from developing programmes for the Academy as a whole to tailor-making new programmes for the School of Chinese Opera, adopting educational technology and innovation.

For Ng, the new post represents a merger of his professional speciality and his interest: "Since I have been learning to sing Chinese opera for eight years, I believe I can act as a bridge between teachers and technicians based on my knowledge of the subject matter. I hope to find a common language between the two groups and put forward feasible plans for change."

During his time at iHub, he developed the online course "Cantonese opera: from backstage to the front" as one of his projects, which won a LearnX Impact Award 2018 for best e-learning module. The four-week course covers different areas related to Cantonese opera, including preparation, rehearsal, performance, and tradition.

"The course, which has both English and Chinese versions, attracted more than 1,000 applicants, of which some 700 opted for the English version," Ng adds. "This showed the

#### 網上課程反應熱烈

在教學創新中心工作期間,吳負責統 籌學院第一個免費粵劇大規模開放網 上課程(MOOC),名為「粵劇:從 後台到前台」,去年更榮獲 LearnX Impact 最佳網上學習模式白金獎。四



星期的課程涵蓋粵劇的前期準備、綵排、演出及傳統四大主題。「這個課程備有中英文兩個版本,共吸引了過千人報讀,當中以英文版的學員較多,共七百多人。相信是由於坊間粵劇相關的英語資料不多,故此課程對外籍人士來說是有效深入了解粵劇的教材。這令我們意識到粵劇教育和推廣也可以發展英語市場。」

#### 全方位基礎培訓

appeal of our teaching modules for people from overseas and underlined the potential of the English-language market."

"Next year, the School will launch a one-year diploma course in Chinese opera foundations targeting secondary school graduates, while the Young Academy Cantonese Opera Troupe of the School continues to promote Cantonese opera among secondary schools and nurture the voungsters' interest and talent so that they can opt for the foundation diploma once they have met the basic admission requirements." Ng says, adding that he has been exploring new learning opportunities for both teachers and students, including summer camps and exchange programmes.

Unlike the traditional training model, the Academy's focus is on developing a global worldview and honing students' allround skills. In this way, graduates should be equipped with both professional techniques and cultural administration and management skills.

"Theatregoers traditionally focus on stars when it comes to Chinese opera. However, the School is pursuing something broader to make sure Chinese opera can thrive," says Ng. 🚓


