

**The General Education** Component at the Academy is integral to the Bachelor of Fine Arts (Honours) and Bachelor of Music (Honours) programmes. The GE component consists of **Liberal Arts Courses** and **Academy Elective Courses**.

**Liberal Arts Courses** are core and required courses equipping students with fundamental cultural knowledge for performing artists in the 21st century.

## Liberal Arts Courses (Four required courses, 8 credits):

- Civilisations I
- Civilisations II
- Major Cultural Issues I
- Major Cultural Issues II

**Academy Elective Courses** comprise courses in five major areas of knowledge, and are designed to enhance the development of articulate and reflective art practitioners. The five areas are:

## **Academy Elective Courses Categories**

Category A: Arts, Literature and Humanities

Category B: Science, Technology and the Environment

Category C: Social, Economic and Cultural Issues

Category D: Portfolio Career

Category E: Interdisciplinary Studies

Students select one course from each of the five categories of **Academy Elective Courses** to complete the 10-credit **requirement.**

Through courses offered by the General Education Unit, students are expected to be cognizant of significant political, economic, social and cultural issues in contemporary society. Students will also gain substantial understandings on their potentials and roles as performing artists, and develop necessary skills to build professional careers.
