The Library's New Era

圖書館的新時代

2020 has been a momentous year. In the shadow of COVID-19, the campus was closed; online teaching changed the way knowledge was imparted and posed fresh challenges to teachers and students about the use of the Internet and mobile networks. The Academy Libraries responded quickly to campus closure to support online teaching and learning. Ms Lisa Kwan, Librarian, remarks, "Libraries need to stay abreast of the times and keep up with the new technologies. The pandemic highlighted the importance of change and adaptation, and the Academy Libraries are no exception."

2020年是翻天覆地的一年,疫情下校園關閉,網上學習改變了舊有的教學模式,對老師和學生來說,利用互聯網和流動通訊網絡進行的教與學都充滿挑戰。演藝學院校園關閉期間,圖書館快速應變,支援師生網上教學。館長關麗嫦 (Lisa Kwan) 說:「因應時代需求,圖書館須要緊貼科技發展,尤其學術圖書館,在疫情下突顯改變的重要性。」科技洪流洶湧襲來,圖書館在保存與革新的方式中重新定位,蛻變成結合知識、教育、文化與生活的共享空間。

Lisa joined the Academy in September last year. Not long after, the pandemic struck. Despite having been here for only a few months, she is impressed by the Academy's unique aura. "This is my first time working in a performing arts conservatory. The atmosphere is very different from academically oriented research universities. Teachers and students here have close relationships, perhaps because the campus is geographically focused. Teachers care a lot about students' feelings and their future, and not only how they perform academically."

Graduate Profiles is an ongoing pilot project at the Academy Libraries. In 2017, the Library collaborated with the School of Drama to display graduates' talent and experiences on the Internet and make their profiles together with related photos and videos visible to the industry and the public. Relevant performances linked to the Digital Performing Arts Repository (DPAR) can also be viewed online. "Graduate Profiles is a showcase of students' potentials and not their teachers' achievements. This shows how much teachers and the Academy care for their students. We are currently discussing similar collaboration with the School of Dance and the School of Theatre and Entertainment Arts. We hope this project can eventually be extended to the remaining three schools in the near future."

Jewel in the Library's Crown

The Academy Libraries comprises the Academy Library which opened in 1986 on the ground floor of the Academic Block; the Music Library, a closed stack library that mainly stores performance scores; and the Film and Television Library, opened in 2007, which is located at the School of Film and Television on the Béthanie Campus. The Library's collection contains precious items donated by supporters. These include the Ernest Read Orchestral Collection, which comprises orchestral scores and parts donated by Academy Honorary Fellow Mr Harry Weinrebe; the music score used by the Band of the Black Watch in Hong Kong before 1997; and the Kotewall Collection and more. Capitalising on modern technology, these precious historical artefacts have been digitised, so their wisdom and legacy can be passed on.

Lisa去年9月加入演藝學院,上任不久即碰上疫情,雖然只在學院短短數月,但她對校園與別不同的氛圍印象深刻。「第一次在文化藝術高等學府工作,氣氛與學術研究型大學截然不同,可能由於校園集中,師生關係密切,老師對同學的關心不止於成績,也在意他們的感受和前途。」

演藝學院圖書館有一項名為畢業生簡歷網頁的先導計劃,2017年與戲劇學院合作,於網頁展示畢業生在校內曾參演劇目和相關的相片及影片等,讓業界及公眾認識他們的才華和演出經驗。而被納入圖書館表演藝術數碼典藏(DPAR)的劇目,讀者更可直接在網上觀看演出片段。Lisa坦言:「畢業生簡歷展示的是學生的個人潛能,而非老師的成就,可見老師和學院對同學的關心。我們現正跟舞蹈學院和舞台及製作藝術學院商討類似計劃,並希望不久將來能夠逐步擴展至其餘三間學院。」

鎮館之寶

圖書館由三部分組成:學院圖書館於1986年啟用,位於教學大樓地下;音樂圖書館為閉架式,主要存放表演樂譜及分譜;電影電視圖書館設於伯大尼校園內的電影電視學院,在2007年啟用。館藏中不少為學院支持者所捐贈,包括由榮譽院士維利比先生捐贈的列特管弦樂樂譜及分譜館藏(Ernest Read Orchestral Collection)、黑衛士軍團在九七回歸前步操演奏時所用的迷你管樂譜(Black Watch Collection)、羅旭和夫人館藏(Kotewall Collection)等。珍貴的歷史遺物

"The Library has many gems. But if I have to choose. I would say the materials in the Archive Collection are the iewel in the Library's crown. The archives are a treasure trove of the performances, productions and events of the Academy since its opening." The items have been digitised and kept in the Library's DPAR for ease of reference by students and teachers.

Strategy for Development - Collaboration, Innovation, Responding to Needs

Libraries in the digital era are no longer simply book depositories. Lisa's first task since joining the Academy Libraries is to refine services using the latest information technology. Building on the solid foundations laid by the former Librarian Ms Ling Wai-king, Lisa adopts a threepronged approach to library service development.

The first is collaboration. Having worked in two university libraries and currently the Vice President of the Hong Kong Library Association, Lisa fully understands the benefits of collaborating with other institutions as well as within the Academy. "We allow our students and teachers to borrow institutional reading cards to use other academic libraries should there be a need. More libraries have been added to the list. The Library continues to provide inter-library loan services with other tertiary institutions, thus expanding the resources available to users. The Library has also joined with other local academic libraries in the consortium acquisition of e-books and e-databases, which strengthens all libraries' negotiation power and allows resource sharing. There are also opportunities for joint staff development that will be explored. Internally, we will collaborate further with different Schools and departments with an eye to offering more effective services."

The second is innovation. "The Library can make use of creativity and information technology to further enhance its services and operational efficiency as well as to attract users to use the Library. With the library system migration in 2018, the Library has launched the new Primo@Lib search platform, allowing a one-stop search for library collection, e-books. e-journals, and various electronic resources. Required electronic materials can also be instantly retrieved on this new platform. We have also started the new linking function. Findit@HKAPA, which allows users to link relevant Google Scholar search results to the fulltext articles and book chapters in the Library's subscribed databases. The Library is in the process of migrating the DPAR to the new library system for enhanced search experience and unified resources management." Other recently introduced services include e-payment, quick battery charging, and Wi-Fi printing services. Users can now directly print from their mobile devices and laptop computers to the designated photocopiers in the Library. Looking ahead, Lisa plans to enhance the Library's website and user guides and reorganise the information resources, with an aim of providing users with better and easier access to library services and information. It will also give the public a better understanding of the library services and development.

The third is understanding users' needs. "Although the Library has subject liaison officers in place to communicate with the six Schools, we plan to organise focus group meetings in the next academic year to actively collect users' feedback and learn what teachers and students need from the Library. This will help us to further develop our collections and services." In the past months, the Library has taken steps to strengthen its communication platform with users by, for example, replacing emails with an online platform for user suggestions and comments,





如今已轉化成數碼檔案,以新面貌保留着舊信息,於 不同時代以最有效的方式傳遞着前人的智慧。「圖書 館有很多珍藏,若要選出鎮館之寶,我認為是演藝 學院檔案資料,保存了由學院啟用至今的各種演出、 製作和活動檔案,就像一個寶庫。」圖書館已把這些 珍貴館藏數碼化,收錄在DPAR,方便師生參考。

發展策略 — 合作、創新、了解需要

隨着數碼時代的到來,圖書館的功能不只是「藏 書閣」,Lisa加入演藝學院後,首要工作是利用資 訊科技進一步優化圖書館服務。在前館長凌慧琼 奠下的穩固基礎下,Lisa會利用三項策略繼續發 展圖書館。

第一項是合作及協商(Collaboration)。Lisa曾於兩 間大學圖書館任職,又身兼香港圖書館協會副主席, 深明對內與對外合作可以為雙方甚至多方帶來更大 效益。「我們會繼續與更多大專院校圖書館安排閱覽 証,讓師生有需要時借用,以進入其他院校圖書館; 館際互借服務可以幫助讀者借用其他圖書館書籍或 取得所需期刊文獻,變相擴闊了圖書館資源;圖書 館今年更進一步參與大專院校圖書館集體採購電子 書和電子資料庫,可以提升一眾圖書館的議價能力, 共享資源;員工交流培訓亦存在合作空間,可以進 一步探討;圖書館亦積極與校內不同部門合作,提 供更多有效和所需的服務。」

第二項是創新 (Innovation)。「圖書館可利用創意 和資訊科技,提升服務和工作效率,吸引讀者多 使用圖書館。2018年更新的圖書館系統推出了全 新資訊搜索平台Primo@Lib,讀者可一站式搜索圖 書館藏品、電子書籍、電子期刊、各項電子資料 等、並可在網上即時取用相關電子資料。圖書館並 推出了Findit@HKAPA連結功能,讓讀者可從Google Scholar的搜索結果連結到圖書館的電子數據庫,以 獲取文章或書籍章節全文。此外,圖書館亦正積極 將DPAR遷移到新圖書館系統,以增強搜索效果和統 一資源管理。」最近圖書館亦推出了電子繳費、快 速充電和無線打印服務, 讀者可從流動電話或手提

電腦直接輸出至圖書館影印機作打印。下一步,Lisa 計劃優化圖書館網頁和指南,整合各項資訊,方便 讀者瀏覽和使用各項服務,同時讓公眾了解圖書館 的服務和發展。

第三項是了解和緊貼讀者需要(Users' need)。「雖 然圖書館有學科聯絡專員作為與各學院的溝通橋樑, 但我們仍計劃在下學年舉辦小組會談,直接收集和多 聽取意見,了解師生的需要,進一步發展館藏及改善 服務。」圖書館在過去數月亦積極改進與讀者的溝通 平台,包括以網上平台取代電郵方式收集讀者意見和 查詢、提供網上平台讓讀者提交採購建議、利用 WhatsApp短訊平台與讀者溝通等。

Alternative Learning

Libraries have become spaces for information sharing and creativity cultivation, thanks to the advancement in information technology. The Academy Libraries have undertaken several projects to facilitate learning in the 21st century. "In 2018, the Library teamed up with the School of Film and Television to add a collection of sound effect files created by its students and teachers to Audio Miner, the collection of sound effect and production music tracks. Students can search and select the required sound effects for their productions through this unique resource, which provides important support to performing arts teaching and learning."

The pandemic has highlighted the indispensable role of online services. Apart from making various electronic resources available, the Academy Libraries introduced a temporary online book request service at the end of February to meet the demands of online teaching and learning. "Students and staff can place requests for circulating books and audiovisual materials and pick them up from library staff outside the Facilities Service Centre on the Wanchai campus." And in a cordial move, overdue fines and book renewals are handled with flexibility.

In the same spirit of cordiality, the Academy Libraries keeps refreshing its relations with staff and students. through the holding of activities such as fai chun writing at Chinese New Year, handicraft workshops, cultural exhibitions, thematic book exhibitions, and talks. "We provide different kinds of learning opportunities to help users understand that there are multiple facets to learning - through books and through other means; at school and lifelong." While facilities and technologies may change, the Academy Libraries will remain steadfast in its support to teachers, students and all other users. Through information exchange, exploration, sharing and creativity, the Library of the new era will continue to play a pivotal role in teaching and learning outside the classroom.

各種電子資料,在2月底更推出臨時網上預約書籍及 藏品服務,以支援下學期網上教學的需要,「師牛們」 在網上搜索平台搜尋到的實體DVD、書籍等,都可 預約,收到圖書館電郵通知後,他們可到灣仔校園 設施服務中心門外與圖書館職員聯絡取書。」校園 關閉期間的逾期罰款與續借安排亦作彈性處理,盡 顯人情味。

説到人情味,圖書館一直透過各類型的活動,連繫着 校內師生職員,包括揮春和手工藝工作坊、文化展 覽、主題書展、講座等。「圖書館須要提供不同學習 機會,讓讀者明白現今學習渠道眾多,他們不單可從 書籍獲得知識,亦可透過另類方式作終身學習。」儘 管設施和技術發展日新月異,圖書館支援學習的功能 始終不變,藉着各種資訊交流、探索、分享和創作 新時代下的圖書館,繼續扮演課堂以外的一個重要角 色。♣

SUMMER PERFORMANCES



The School of Dance Summer Performances are a celebration of the commitment, hard work and robust partnership with the local dance sector. The School of Dance invited the artistic directors of three Hong Kong flagship dance companies to create and restage their works for senior and final year students, to enhance their professional dance training and build a solid foundation for the graduating class before they embark on a dance career.

The first piece, **A Step**, choreographed by Yang Yuntao, Artistic Director of Hong Kong Dance Company, aims to help graduating Chinese Dance students explore the shifting dynamics of professionalism from studentship. **Canon** is a new work choreographed by Dominic Wong, Associate Artistic Director of the City Contemporary Dance Company in collaboration with Contemporary Dance students and sound designers. Canon probes meaning, understanding and responses as one searches for a unique personal voices in unsettling times. The final piece is an excerpt from **Juanita v Alicia** choreographed by Septime Webre, Artistic Director of Hong Kong Ballet and restaged by Septime and Luis R. Torres. The piece was initially choreographed for The Washington Ballet in 2000, demanding dynamic physicality in the upper body and exploring movement outside the traditional ballet vocabulary. The School of Theatre and Entertainment Arts is once again collaborating in all technical aspects. Through the productions, faculty and students will be brought closer together, supporting each other in teaching and learning. 🚓






